ITINERARY

- OCT 17 — TRAVEL

We fly from Dallas DFW to Tel Aviv. We check-in for our flight three hours before departure. We arrive Israel the following day. [Flight TBA]

- OCT 18 — OLD TOWN JAFFA

Atlas Markethouse Hotel **** Upon arrival we will be greeted by our tour guide, Aviv. Our coach takes us to our hotel where we will enjoy a welcome beverage and short orientation. Enjoy the quaint streets and restaurants.

- OCT 19 — OLD TOWN JAFFA

After a delicious traditional breakfast spread. At 9:30 AM, we enjoy a guided walking tour of historic Jaffa. We learn of Peter raising Tabitha from the dead, Jonah, and the importance of Jaffa as a trade town. [B]

- OCT 20 — EMMAUS & MT. CARMEL Legacy Hotel Nazareth ****

At 9am we load our coach to visit the ancient Greek city of Emmaus, where Jesus appeared and broke bread with the two disciples after his resurrection. We continue to Caesarea, built by Herod the Great in honor of Augustus Caesar and considered the traditional site of Paul's imprisonment before his trial in Rome. We have lunch, followed by Mt. Carmel, where Elijah rebuked the priests of Baal. We check into our 4-star Legacy Hotel in Nazareth, freshen up, and enjoy a traditional Israeli dinner in the hotel restaurant. [B,(L\$20),D]

- OCT 21 — NAZARETH

At 9:30am we will enjoy a guided walking tour of the Greek Orthodox Church of the Annunciation, followed by a short walk through the quaint old town of Nazareth. We will visit archeological sites that inform us of the infrastructure in Nazareth at the time of Jesus. We'll sit down with a local shopkeeper who will demonstrate Middle Eastern traditions and cultures through word and song. The shopkeeper is a professional Armenian guide, who will also share her families story as one of the early Christian settlers in Israel. In the afternoon, we go to Nazareth Village, an incredible outdoor museum that depicts the daily life and business of Nazareth during the time of Jesus. We learn more of the work and mission of the Palestinian christian group of Sabeel Ministries. [B,D]

- OCT 22 — THE SEA OF GALILEE

At 9am we drive through Tiberias on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. We will enjoy a beautiful boat tour on the Sea of Galilee. We will enjoy a catch of the day fish lunch. After lunch, we will visit Capernaum, the site of Jesus' teachings and the remains of a second-century synagogue. We will visit Magdala, the newest, and perhaps most important first century archealogical site. It is also the site of a modern church built on the remains of a firstcentury Synagogue. We will also visit the Mount of Beatitudes, the site of Jesus' 'Sermon on the Mount', overlooking the Sea of Galilee [B,L\$20,D]

- OCT 23 — RIVER JORDAN TO JERUSALEM Atlas Arthur Hotel ****

At 8am we drive to Megiddo, one of the most important archeological excavations in Israel. We continue our drive through Beit Shean National Park, also one of Israel's largest archaeological sites with its ancient archaeological mound and ongoing excavations exposing the vast Roman-Byzantine city. We continue south along the Jordan Rift Valley and ascend to Jerusalem through the Judean Desert. After checking into the Three Arches Hotel, we will enjoy a group dinner in the restaurant of our hotel. [B,L\$20,D]



- OCT 24 — JERUSALEM

Enjoy a traditional breakfast in the city of Jerusalem. At 9am, we begin our day with a guided walking tour of Jerusalem. We will see the Western Wall, the Temple Mount, Dome of the Rock, and we walk sections of the Stations of the Cross that leads us to the Evangelical Church of the Calvary (Lutheran,) where we sit and ponder for a few minutes. Lunch is on our own and we leave a little time for shopping. Afterwards, we will visit to the church of the Holy Sepulchre, if the lines are long into the sepulchre, you may wait and go early in the morning when the lines are shorter. The rest of the day will be at your own leisure and pace. [B]

- OCT 25 — HEBRON & PATRIARCHS

At 9am, we drive to Hebron and visit the Cave of the Patriarchs. We learn of the covenant that Abraham made with God. The burial place is important to all Abrahamic faiths, and it is considered the second most important place in Judaism after the Temple in Jerusalem. [B,L\$20]

- OCT 26 — JERUSALEM

At 9am, we begin the day with a drive to the beautiful Mount of Olives to behold the breath-taking panorama of the Holy City. Then we descend (walking or coach) to Gethsemane with its ancient olive grove, where tradition holds that Jesus prayed prior to his arrest and crucifixion. We drive to Bethlehem where we have lunch by Shepherd's Field, we visit the Church of the Nativity, and the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Palestine and Jordan. We take time for a little shopping at the olive wood factory in Bethlehem, before returning to our hotel in Jerusalem. [B,L\$20]

- OCT 27 — THE DEAD SEA, QUMRAN & MASADA

At 8am, our coach-driver will take us to the Dead Sea Basin where we will visit Qumran to explore the area where the Dead Sea sect established a community and we'll see the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. We'll drive to Masada and ascend this wilderness mountain fortress in a cable car; walk through the remains of the palace, water cisterns and fortifications built by King Herod and hear about the Zealots who lived here until the bitter end. There is a food court at Masada where we will have lunch. Bring a swim suit if you want to float on the Dead Sea. Dinner is on your own in Jerusalem. [B,L\$20]

- OCT 28 — JERUSALEM

Have another cup of strong coffee for breakfast and prepare for our final walking tour. At 9am, we'll have a short hike to Mount Zion where we see King David's Tomb, the site of The Upper Room. We visit the church of St. Anne by the Pool of Bethesda. We conclude our walking tour by visiting the Garden of the Empty Tomb, where we will celebrate Holy Communion. We will celebrate our tour with a group dinner at our hotel restaurant at 6pm. [B,D]
